We are aware of our professional limitations. In case of doubt, we recommend that our clients seek appropriate professional support. Based on that information, we will determine together if and how the working relationship can continue.

Our working relationships with clients are based on eye-level communication and complete respect for our clients' boundaries.

We are aware of the potential complications and risks that can arise in a student/teacher (client/practitioner) relationship, and we will not use our position for any form of exploitation or personal benefit.

We are aware of our personal biases and tendencies. Therefore, we commit to regular consultations and learning opportunities with our colleagues and other experts.

We are aware that mistakes can happen, and we will always do our best to correct our mistakes.

We act according to the legal requirements of the countries we choose to work in, which includes having the relevant professional and liability insurance.
